Key questions:

How can you make 2? How can you make 3? How can you make 4?

Which two numbers make 5? How many ways can you make 5?

I have 2 pencils. How many more do I need to make 5?

Top Tips

Use practical resources (toys, food, objects) to find different ways of making 2,3,4 and 5. For example, 2 yellow bricks and 3 red bricks makes 5. One fork and four spoons make 5. You can make number bond stories. For example, there are four chicks and one lamb in the field. There are 5 animals because four and one make five.
