Key Questions



Count forwards and backwards in steps of two.

Count on in steps of 5 from 0 to 100 and back again.

Count in tens to 100 – forwards and backwards.

When counting on in 10's, which number comes after 30?

When counting back in 5's, which number comes after 15? 2, 4, __, 8, 10. Which number is missing?

Top Tips

Practise little and often. Chant them as often as you can. Make a game out of it.
