Target: Know one more and one less than any number to 5

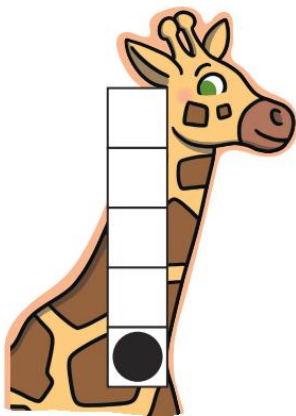
By the end of this half term, children should know and be able to recall the following facts instantly:

Key vocabulary

more than, less than, one more, one less,
add, plus, subtract, take away

Key questions

What is one more than 3?
What is one less than 3?



Examples:

The giraffe has one spot. If we add one more, how many spots does it have now?

The giraffe has one spot. If we take a spot away how many spots does it have now?
What is one less than one?

Top Tips

Try to practise these facts practically. e.g. with food or lego bricks. When we take one away, how many do we have left now? If we add one more, how many do we have now? Practise the language of more and less. Can you spot a tree with more or less leaves than another tree.
