Week 3	Words where '-ing', '-er' and '-ed' are added to multisyllabic words	gardening, gardener, limited, limiting, developing, developed, listening, listened, covered, covering
Week 4	Words where '-ing', '-en' and '-ed' are added to multisyllabic words	forgetting, forgotten, beginning, preferred, permitted, regretting, committed, forbidden, propelled, equipped
Week 5	Challenge words	centre, decide, disappear, early, heart, learn, minute, notice, regular, therefore
Week 6	Words with the digraph 'ai' and the tetragraph 'aigh'	straight, fainted, strainer, claimed, snail, painter, waist, chained, failure, waiter
