Week 1	Words ending in '-le'	battle, article, struggle, possible, capable, settle, humble, terrible, example, adjustable
Week 2	Words ending in '-ly' where the base word ends in 'le'	gently, humbly, durable, incredibly, possibly, simply, nobly, terribly, responsibly, wrinkly
Week 3	Words ending in '-ly' where the base word ends in 'ic'	basically, frantically, logically, tragically, magically, publicly, dramatically, historically, automatically, specifically,
Week 4	Words ending in '-ly'; exceptions	Truly, drily, slyly, fully, coyly, duly, daily, shyly, wholly, happily
Week 5	Challenge Words	address, arrive, certain, experience, history, mention, occasionally, probably, reign, sentence
