We follow the National Curriculum and programmes of study and teachers plan together to ensure the same coverage in each class within a year group. We have detailed policies for all subjects taught which are available on our website for you to read.

Our curriculum also includes a range of extra-curricular activities in order to enrich the children's learning and experiences.

Developing our children to become strong readers, writers and mathematicians is key to their success and underpins all parts of the children's learning and experiences.

We aim to:
